### What is Corflute®?

Corflute® is a twin wall 100% recyclable polypropylene (PP) sheet product, commonly chosen for its' strength, durability and environmental credentials. Corflute® is used across the signage, packaging, material handling and building industries.

### **About Corex Recycling**

When your Corflute® products are ready to retire or if you have post-industrial waste you want to return, <a href="Corex Recycling">Corex Recycling</a> can recycle and reuse them. Every sheet of Corflute® is invited to be brought back. We supply industrial size recycling bins called <a href="Corpaks®">Corpaks®</a> to our clients who use high volumes of Corflute®.

We take back a range of other plastics for recycling as well. If you would like other PP (polypropylene) and HDPE (Polyethylene) products recycled, <u>contact us</u> and we will provide a recycling solution that suits your location and product. **Please note:** We cannot accept common plastics such as Acrylic (Perspex<sup>TM</sup>), and polystyrene foam.

Our Corex Recycling facility works alongside the factory that produces Corflute®.

### What happens to the plastic that's brought back to Corex Recycling?

We process and recycle every kilogram of plastic we receive on site. That means that we do not export anything! All of the processed material returned to us have a use within Corex Plastics. In the rare occasion that Corex Plastics do not have a use to suit the recycled polymer, we will only then sell to local plastic manufacturers that make products that could be sent back to us for recycling.

### What's the cost to you to recycle Corflute®?

Corex Recycling operates in Dandenong, Victoria. There is no charge for processing and recycling compatible plastic delivered to our site.

NSW Customers: We have partnered with <a href="Paper Resource">Paper Resource</a> to offer our NSW customers a local collection hub. If you are in NSW, answer the questions below and email Chad Loumbos at Paper Resource <a href="mailto:chad@paperresource.com.au">chad@paperresource.com.au</a> with you answers for a quote. Corex Recycling will not charge you for transport from NSW to Victoria, or for recycling of your materials. The only charges will come from Paper Resource.

### How it works?

Perhaps you are a printer using Corflute® for your displays and have scrap sheet after cutting the job. Or you may have used Corflute® signage in election campaign materials and looking for an alternative to throwing the used signage in the bin? We have various options to support you.

### Please answer these questions, along with suppling a photo of your materials.

1. What type of plastic do you have? i.e., Corflute, solid PP, HDPE	
2. What form is it in? e.g., flat sheet on a pallet, loose, container etc.	
3. Are there any contaminants such as metal, paper and other plastics? (Learn about removing contaminants below)	
4. How much plastic would you like recycled? Estimate volume (weight e.g., 200 kg's, 1 ton. etc. or approx. how many signs etc.	
5. Address and where the waste material is located?	
6. Are you a customer of Corex or of a Corflute Distributor?

### Preparing your Corflute® for recycling

So that we can recycle your used Corflute®, we need you to check for contaminants and remove them.

At Corex Recycling, we refer to a contaminant as the presence of materials or a substance other that Corflute®. We need your Corflute® to be free of contaminates so that we can; shred, melt and make recycled pellets from it which enables us to make products for tomorrow.

Here are the steps to check for and remove contaminants. It's easier than you think!

#### 1. Check for contaminants

Your Corflute® may have no contaminants. If your graphics have been printed directly to the Corflute® and there are no eyelets, you probably have contaminant free Corflute®.

However, there are many occasions when other elements are used(contaminants), in particular when fabricating a Corflute® sign.

#### Contaminants include:

- Eyelets around the holes
- Plastic and metal
- PVC protective film if your Corflute® sign is super shiny and you can pick a layer of plastic from a corner, this is a PVC laminate
- PVC pockets
- Paper, adhesive tapes, Velcro

#### 2. Remove contaminants

- Eyelets Using a Stanley knife, cut the Corflute® area where the eyelets are attached. It's easiest to cut a straight line across the top of the sheet and so on.
- PVC laminate Pick a corner and continue to peel the PVC from the Corflute.
- Remove and paper and adhesive tapes.



### Getting your Corflute® back to us.

After you answer the above questions along with a photo, Corex Recycling will be able to ascertain which option will support your plastic return.

1. Smaller volumes - equivalent of half of an intermediate bulk container (IBC) or a car boot load etc.

**VICTORIA:** Corex Recycling can facilitate a contact-free drop off at our Dandenong South site for smaller volumes of plastic. **Phone** Corex Recycling on +61 3 9238 1362 30 minutes prior to your planned drop-off with company name and approximate volume of material being returned.

**NSW:** You can drop your small quantities of Corflute® at Paper Resource during business hours. You don't need to contact Paper Resource prior to drop-off as long as meet the contamination guidelines.

#### 2. Larger volumes

For larger volumes of Corflute®, we can provide transport and Corpak containers. If you are able to hold 6 or more of our Corpak's and have forklift access, this option could be suitable to your business and we may offer you a FOC Corflute® collection service. Corex Recycling can offer the FOC service to businesses located in metropolitan VIC.
